This Privacy Policy was last revised on 30th May, 2019.

Definitions · Agreement to applicable policies

This Privacy Policy explains the collection, use, processing, transferring and disclosure of personal information by the website located at www.donaldjenkins.com ("donaldjenkins.com" or "this Website"), and all associated sites linked to www.donaldjenkins.com by Donald Jenkins, his subsidiaries and affiliates, including other donaldjenkins.* sites around the world (collectively, "this Website"). This Website is the property of Donald Jenkins ("Donald Jenkins") and his licensors.

This Privacy Policy is incorporated into the [Terms of Service](#) for this Website, to which you also hereby represent that you agree.

As used in this policy, "personal information", also referred to as "Personal Data" means information that would allow someone to identify you, including your name, email address, IP address, or other information from which someone could deduce your identity.

Ways in which this Website collects and uses personal information

Types of Data collected

Among the types of Personal Data that this Website collects, by itself or through third parties, there are: Cookies, Usage Data, email address, first name and last name.

Complete details on each type of Personal Data collected are provided in the dedicated sections of this Privacy Policy or by specific explanation texts displayed prior to the Data collection.

Personal Data may be freely provided by the User, or, in case of Usage Data, collected automatically when using this Website. Unless specified otherwise, all Data requested by this Website is mandatory and failure to provide this Data may make it impossible for this Website to provide its services. In cases where this Website specifically states that some Data is not mandatory, Users are free not to communicate this Data without consequences to the availability or the functioning of the Service.

Users who are uncertain about which Personal Data is mandatory are welcome to contact this Website.

Any use of Cookies – or of other tracking tools – by this Website or by the owners of third-party services used by this Website serves the purpose of providing the Service required by the User, in addition to any other purposes described in the present document and in the [Cookie Policy](#), if available.

Users are responsible for any third-party Personal Data obtained, published or shared through this Website and confirm that they have the third party's consent to provide the Data to this Website.

Mode and place of processing the Data · Methods of processing

This Website takes appropriate security measures to prevent unauthorized access, disclosure, modification, or unauthorized destruction of the Data.

The Data processing is carried out using computers and/or IT enabled tools, following organizational procedures and modes strictly related to the purposes indicated. In addition to this Website, in some cases, the Data may be accessible to certain types of persons in charge of, or involved with the operation of this Website (administration, sales, marketing, legal, system administration) or external parties (such as third-party technical service providers, mail carriers, hosting providers, IT companies, communications agencies) appointed, if necessary, as Data Processors by this Website. The updated list of these parties may be requested from this Website at any time.

Legal basis of processing

This Website may process Personal Data relating to Users if one of the following applies:

Users have given their consent for one or more specific purposes. Note: Under some legislations this Website may be allowed to process Personal Data until the User objects to such processing ("opt-out"), without having to rely on consent or any other of the following legal bases. This, however, does not apply:

Legal Basis for Processing Personal Data Under General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

Location

The Data is processed at this Website's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located.

Retention time
